Other Problems

- 1. Let V and W be vector spaces over the same field of scalars and let $L:V\mapsto W$ be linear. Prove that L(V) is a subspace of W and $\ker L$ is a subspace of V.
- 2. Show that isomorphism is an equivalence relation. That is, for vector spaces V, W, and U over the same scalar field, show that
 - (a) $V \cong V$,
 - (b) if $V \cong W$, then $W \cong V$, and
 - (c) if $V \cong W$ and $W \cong U$, then $V \cong U$.

Note: Since no claim is made about the spaces having finite dimension, you cannot invoke Theorem 6.25.
