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1 Problems

Putnam 2010/B4. Find all pairs of polynomials p(x) and q(x) with real coefficients for which

$$p(x)q(x+1) - p(x+1)q(x) = 1.$$

Putnam 2010/B5. Is there a strictly increasing function $f: \mathbb{R} \to \mathbb{R}$ such that f'(x) = f(f(x)) for all x?

Putnam 2010/B6. Let A be an $n \times n$ matrix of real numbers for some $n \ge 1$. For each positive integer k, let $A^{[k]}$ be the matrix obtained by raising each entry to the kth power. Show that if $A^k = A^{[k]}$ for $k = 1, 2, \ldots, n+1$, then $A^k = A^{[k]}$ for all $k \ge 1$.
